- The event is open to anyone involved in Girlguiding Staffordshire
- Please bring a passport sized photograph with your name on the back
- A video and photographs will be taken on the day and used to publicise girlguiding
- Your act can be anything that is entertaining e.g. singing dancing , acting juggling, playing an instrument etc, etc
- The audition piece must be no more than 2 minutes in duration
- The entrant must provide any costume or prop used
- The entrant must provide any music on a CD. The disc must be clearly marked with the name and track to be played and playable on a standard CD system
- Vocalists should use an instrumental backing track
- All entrants must be available to perform at the Shugborough Centenary 2010 Launch Party on September 5th 2009 if successful
- Changing rooms will be available if required
- Entrants will be issued with a number on arrival and brought onto stage in numerical order to perform
- Guiding friends and families are welcome to attend the event and watch the performances, space permitting
- A lunch break will be taken between 1 & 2pm. Therefore if appropriate please bring along drinks and packed lunch
- The decision of the judging panel will be final and no discussions will be entered into
- Each entrant will be presented with a certificate for taking part and the winner notified by telephone at the latest 4th April 2009 and announced on the website www.girlguidingstaffordshire.org.uk
